

This Policy applies to all elements in the Chain of Responsibility meaning Loaders, Packers, Consignees and Consignors, Drivers, Contractors, those purchasing and maintaining Transdev Vehicles as well as those in management control of these activities.

Transdev NSW is committed to conducting and managing its business activities in compliance with all applicable National and State Laws, Regulations and Codes of Practice, to ensure the safety of our staff and the safety of all road users.

We will ensure that through management and awareness of the Chain or Responsibility, that we:

- Comply with all applicable road laws;
- Executive Officers have a safety duty and will exercise due diligence to ensure Transdev NSW complies with this duty;
- Will not knowingly make, meet or encourage any requirement or demand that could breach applicable road laws;
- Ensure that all equipment is safe;
- Will be known as courteous users of the road network.

Specifically, we will:

- Ensure that this policy is communicated across our business and to our suppliers and contractors;
- Ensure that all parties to the Chain of responsibility are trained and competent in their roles;
- Include chain of responsibility clauses are specified in all contracts and services;
- Implement programs to manage fatigue and speed;
- Maintain our equipment to a high standard and keep abreast of innovations to support and ensure vehicle safety;
- Implement strict alcohol and drug policies;
- Encourage driver health and wellbeing;
- Manage mass, dimension and load issues in accordance with legal and safe operating requirements;
- Establish open communication system to ensure issues and concerns reach management and are acted upon, and;
- Implement and maintain systems and regularly audit our performance to ensure compliance with this Policy throughout Transdev NSW.
